

# Notice of Race

### 2008 Tommy Wunderlick Memorial Classic

#### AUGUST 30-31, 2008

#### 1. Rules

This Race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

#### 2. Eligibility and Entry

**2.1.** The event is open to all ballast-keel monohull sailboats with an overall length of 20 feet or greater.

**2.2.** Competitors may enter the Spinnaker Class or the Cruising Sails Class (non-spinnaker). Boats will race with PHRF handicaps.

**2.3.** Boats may register in advance by completing a registration form and sending it with the appropriate fee to the address indicated below, on-line at [www.texomasailing.org](http://www.texomasailing.org) Fees must be paid no later than 14:45 August 30, 2008. Please pre-register on-line.

#### 3. Fees

**3.1.** Required entry fee for this event is \$35. The entry fee for US Sailing members is \$30. Make all checks payable to TSC.

**3.2.** Breakfast will be served on August 31. Breakfast cost is \$5.00 per person. Please make reservations so we are sure to have enough food. Please RSVP at [texomasailing.org](http://texomasailing.org).

#### 4. Schedule

**4.1.** August 30, 2008: Registration from 12:00 -14:45 at TSC Clubhouse, Skippers' meeting will be held at 15:00 at the TSC clubhouse, The 2008 Classic will be one race, with the warning signal at 16:55.

**4.2.** August 31, 2008: Eye openers at 08:00, breakfast at 08:30, awards at 09:00 at the TSC Clubhouse.

#### 5. Sailing Instructions

**5.1.** The race will be sailed under the sailing instructions provided at the skippers' meeting @ 15:00 on August 30, 2008.

#### 6. Venue

**6.1.** The event site will be at Texoma Sailing Club, at Grandpappy Point Marina.

**6.2.** The racing area will be on Lake Texoma, with specific areas outlined at the Skippers' Meeting.

#### 7. Course

**7.1.** The exact course(s) will be announced at the Skippers' Meeting and may be published in the sailing instructions; course lengths will be planned to allow all boats to finish by midnight. Approximate GPS coordinates of racing marks can be obtained on [www.texomasailing.org](http://www.texomasailing.org) and will be included with the sailing instructions.

#### 8. Prizes

**8.1.** Boats in first, second or third place in the final standings in each class shall receive an award. If there are 4 or less boats in a class only two awards will be given. If there are 2 or less boats in a class only one award will be given. The name of the skipper and first place boat in each class will also be inscribed on the Tommy Wunderlick Perpetual Trophy.

#### 9. Additional Requirements

**9.1.** All boats must be equipped with a working VHF radio, either fixed or handheld, for use in hailing by the Race Committee, check-in during the race, and to aid in rescue.
